# Where does California's water come from?



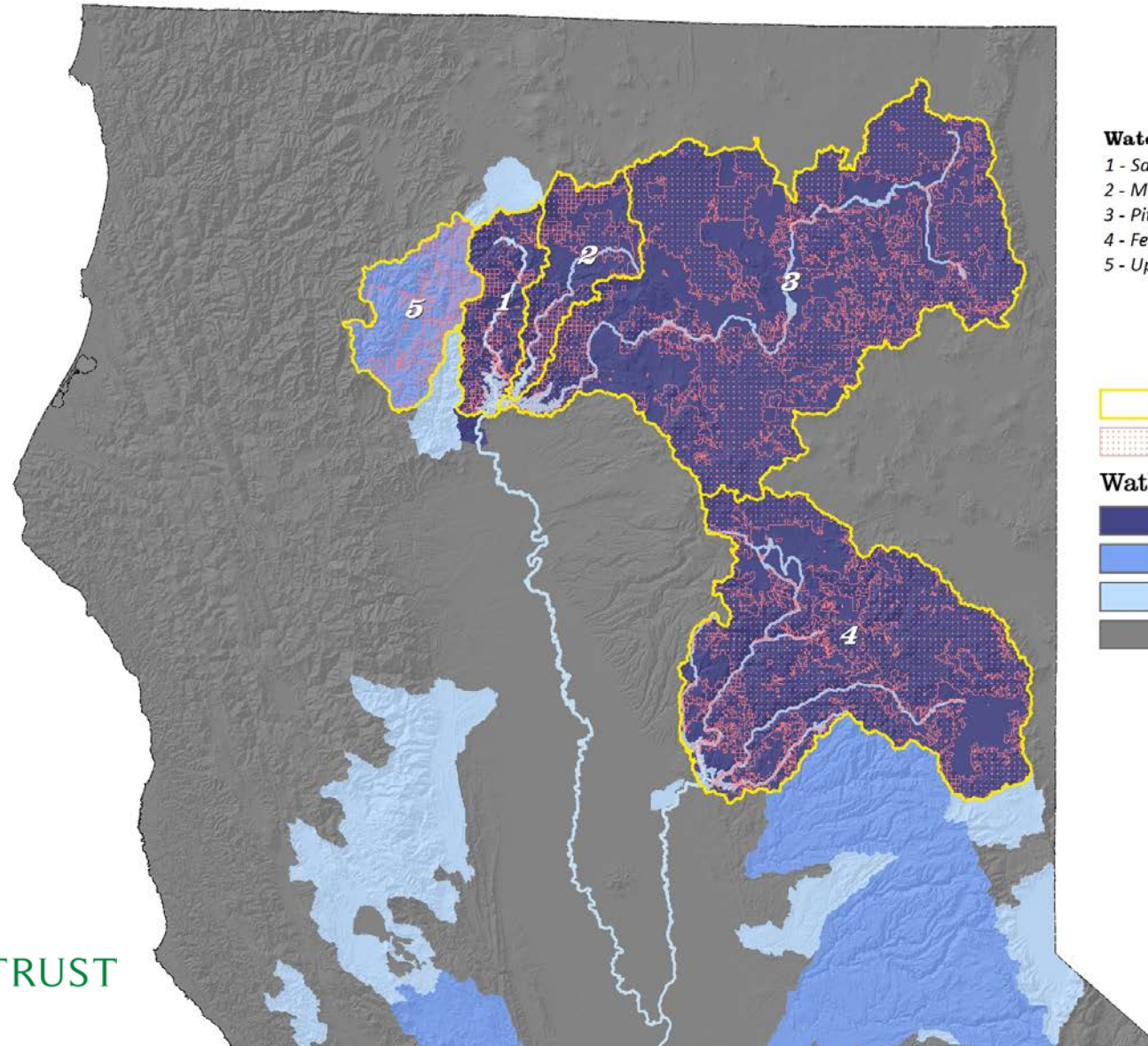
The Klamath-Cascade region provides:

- 60% of irrigated agriculture water
- 80% of freshwater into SF Bay
- 40% of LA and San Diego's drinking water
- Drinking water for 25 million people

- 5 - Upper Trinity



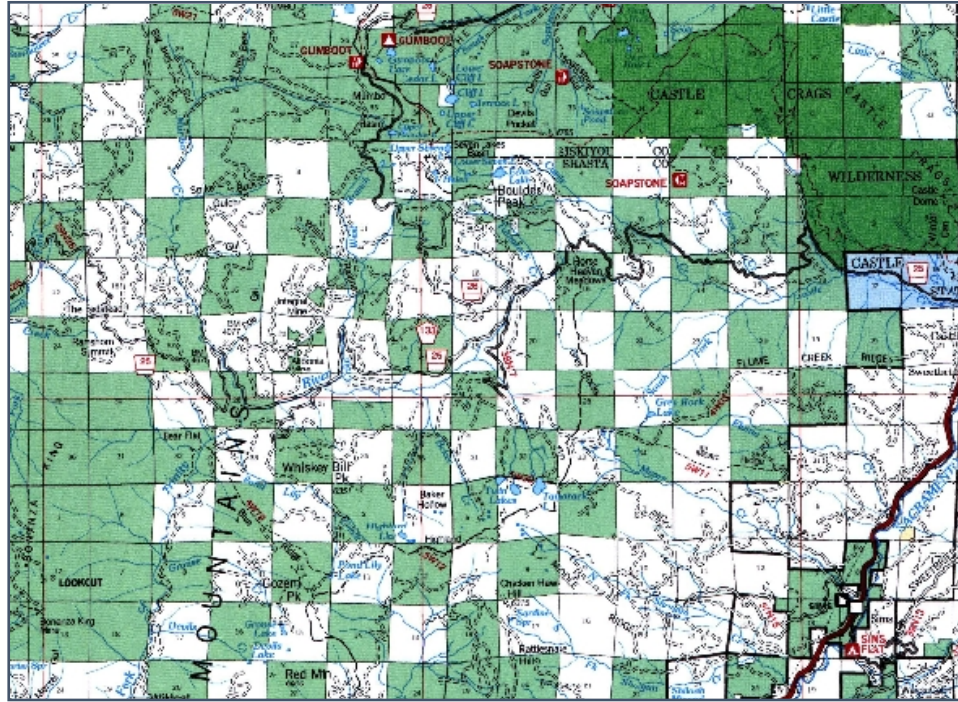

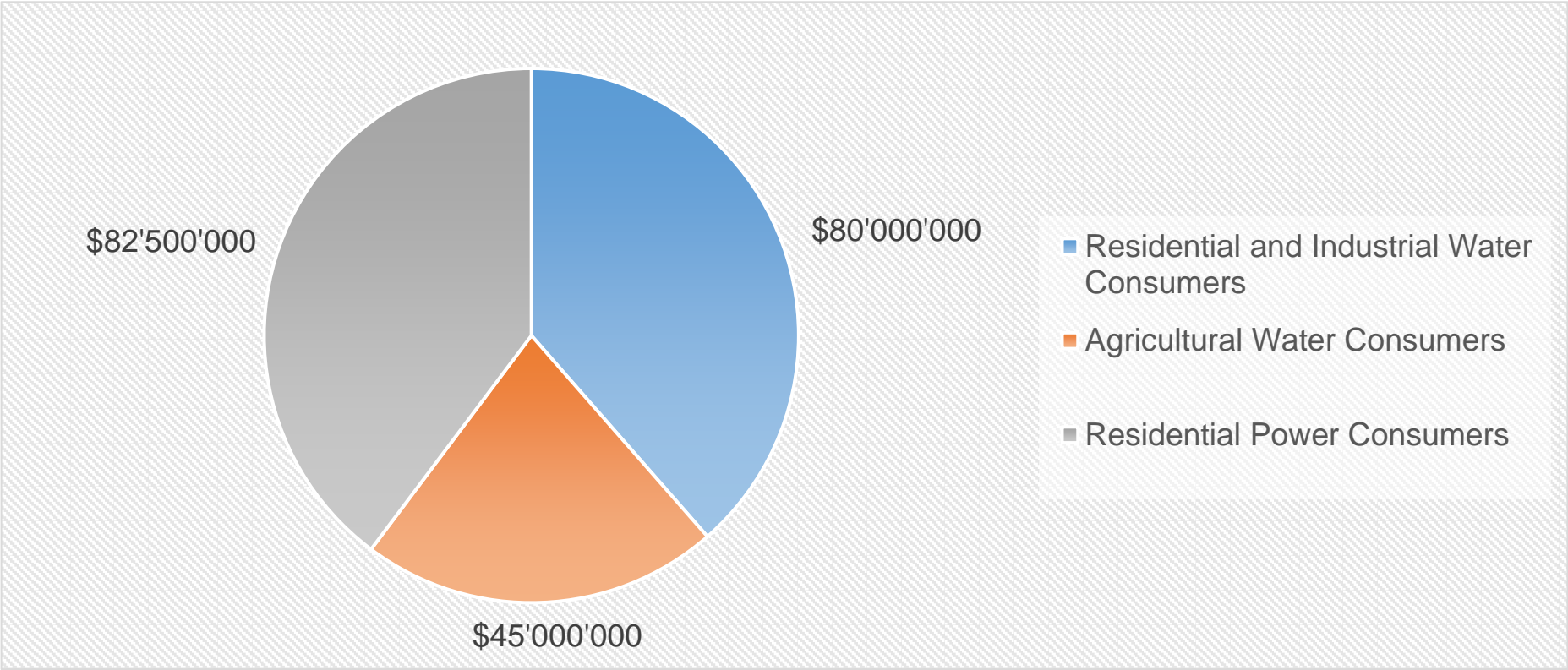

Customer Base	Charge	Units
Residential and Industrial Water Consumers	\$4.00	per customer per year
Agricultural Water Consumers	\$15.00	per acre foot per year
Residential Power Consumers	\$9.00	per residential customer per year
